Practice Exams not only prepare young people for their final assessments but also allow us to identify areas for improvement and set clear, personalised targets to ensure each learner achieves their best.

If your child has three exams scheduled on the same day, they should speak with their teachers. To support their wellbeing, we will reschedule one of the exams to a Friday session, ensuring a more balanced and manageable timetable.

Where possible, please avoid turning up at the school without a prior appointment. Instead, please contact us beforehand so a mutually convenient time can be arranged to meet.

We aim to respond to phone and email queries within 2-3 days. When you contact by phone or email, please be ready to provide:

- Your full name and relationship to the pupil
- The pupil's full name
- The pupil's tutor class or house
- Details of what the query is.

If all of this information is provided in your email or in the initial phone call, it enables staff to direct your query to the right person and allows staff to prioritise urgent issues.


