Respect – we want our young people to develop self-respect and pride in how they look, and in their community.




Inveralmond CHS Uniform Policy



School tie with a black or white formal shirt (long or short sleeved) or a sweatshirt with school logo Black jumper or cardigan School blazer (optional) Must be black. Pupils can choose to wear trousers, a skirt, jeans, formal shorts, jogging bottoms or thick leggings Shoes must be mostly black







Our uniform policy promotes accessible and equitable uniform items that can be reasonably expected to be worn by all pupils. Parent/carers are asked to co-operate with the school in encouraging the wearing of our school uniform.

Shirt: plain black or white






















Jumper: plain black
