## **S6 upcoming events and celebrations**

S6 pupils are coming to the end of their time with us at Inveralmond and we are delighted to be able to provide dates and times of the class of 2026 celebration events which mark the end of their time with us in school.

### **Graduation**

The graduation this year will take place in the Assembly Hall on Thursday the 16th of April. The plan for the evening is:

**5pm:** Welcome refreshments and photographs. All S6 pupils and accompanying guests are invited to attend from 5pm to take photographs in the assembly hall and enjoy some light refreshments prior to commencement of the graduation ceremony.

**6pm:** Graduation begins promptly at 6pm and the event will finish at approximately 8pm.

We anticipate a large turnout to share in this very special day and would encourage families who wish to mark the occasion with photographs to arrive prompt at 5pm to ensure they are able to do so with ease. We request pupils wear full school uniform for the graduation ceremony.

S6 leavers can collect 2 tickets each for the Graduation Ceremony from the wellbeing centre. If further tickets are required please request these when collecting the initial 2 which everyone is allocated, this will allow us to ensure adequate seating for guests on the evening.

### **S6 last day**

The S6 last day of term is Friday 17<sup>th</sup> of April 2026. This is the official start to study leave and S6 pupils come off the school role from the 31<sup>st</sup> of May. The S6 pupils will celebrate the 17<sup>th</sup> of April in the games hall with singing, a bouncy castle and games. This is an exciting day where they can enjoy having their teachers visit them in the hall and sign each other shirts as a keepsake from their time with us at Inveralmond.

There will be refreshments provided on the day for the young people to enjoy and pupils will begin at 9:25am and finish at 12:00 noon. In the past our pupils have always had a lovely day and their last experience in school has been a positive one.

It will be made clear to pupils in advance that any person who jeopardises the enjoyment of others, or health and safety in the school will be removed from the Prom guest list without refund.
